LEICESTERSHIRE THURSDAY FOOTBALL LEAGUE.

A meeting of the above league was held on Thursday evening at the Durham Ox Hotel, there being present Messrs. Hanson, Wells (Victoria), Nicholls (Carlton United), Hughes, Toon (Thursday Rovers), James (Post Office), Hawkins (Hinckley), and E. B. Smithson, the referee.—The Post Office F.C. protested against their game with the Thursday Rovers counting as a league match, on the grounds that 20 minutes' short time was played. The league, however, decided that it must stand as a league match. The Banks F.C. reported Hinckley for nonfulfilment of fixture on October 17, and after hearing the explanation from the Hinckley representative, it was decided not to impose a fine, but Hinckley were requested to arrange a new fixture. It was decided to play a match, Champion v. Rest of the League, on April 9, on the Victoria Park, and a committee consisting of Messrs. Pywell, Nicholls, and James were chosen to select the team to represent the Rest of the League.
