### **Match Reports**

### #1 THE BASS CHARITY CUP. BURTON WANDERERS (HOLDERS) v. LEICESTER

This semi-final tie the Swifts' ground Burton last (Wednesday) night, before 5,000 spectators. The first portion of the game was fast and exciting, but neither side could score. Early the second half Cunningham, of the Wanderers, retired hurt, but returned after being medically treated. Play continued remarkably even for a further twenty minutes, when Garfield scored a grand goal for the Wanderers. Nothing further was scored, and the game ended - Burton Wanderers, one goal; Leicester Fosse, nil. Sporting Life – 26 March 1896
