Anstey Town, Hugglescote Robins Hood, Loughborough Athletic, and Whitwick Town resigned from the League at the end of the 1898-99 season. Anstey joined the Leicester & District League, Hugglescote joined the Coalville Amateur League and Loughborough the Loughborough Amateur League They were replaced by two teams from out of the county – Burton Swifts Reserves and Nuneaton Town.

Nuneaton failed to play postponed matches at Burton and Gresley as ordered by the League. Furthermore, no results have been found for three Swadlincote games.

Published results are at odds with the League table above. For example, according to the table above Gresley drew three games – yet four drawn match reports have been found. One possible explanation for this is the Gresley's home game with Coalville Town played on the 30 December which ended in a victory for Coalville by 2 goals to one, was replayed – for either an infringement of League rules or abandoned as stated in the Gresley Rovers archive. The replayed game which took place towards the end of April ended in a 2-2 draw. It appears that the outcome of the first game was never deleted from the League table

Also match reports for two drawn games for Barwell have been – yet the League table only states 1.

Using available information, it seems highly probable that the three unknown Swadlincote results they beat Burton, drew with Coalville Albion and lost against Earl Shilton. If these results are correct, then the final League standings would be:

A disgraceful affray took place in a Leicestershire Senior League fixture [currently unknown], in which a player in going to the assistance of a referee, was severely injured. As that club (Gresley) belonged to the Derbyshire Association, the matter was dealt by them, and the player was suspended from taking any further part in the game. The Derbyshire Association presented the player who protected the Leicestershire referee with a gold medal.

Burton Swifts' Reserve had won championship of the Burton and District League narrowly missing securing premier honours in the First Division of the Derby and District competition last season.

LEICESTERSHIRE SENIOR LEAGUE.

HINCKLEY v. BURTON SWIFTS RESERVES.

Played on the Holywell Ground, Hinckley, on Saturday, before a very good gate. There was a deal of speculation and uncertainty as to the outcome of the game, this being the first year the Swifts have tried conclusions in the Leicestershire Senior League. The result was more than encouraging to Hinckley's prospects in the League, especially as during the second half they were handicapped by the absence of Dewey, who in a collision had severely strained the ligament of his thigh. The game started in a thick fog, which, from a spectator's point of view, spoiled the game, it being impossible at times to see across the ground, and the points of the play were difficult to follow. Hinckley won the toss, and kicked down hill. After a few minutes in mid-field Beadsworth took the ball into the visitors' territory, and centering Gilchrist took a shot, which resulted in a corner, and a second one was kicked out. Hinckley continued pressing, but their shooting was again poor. Then Sellers got away on the wing, and, with a splendid centre, transferred to Burton, who scored for the Swifts after 20 minutes' play. Unfortunately, Underwood collided and was hurt at the same moment. Hinckley again pressed on restarting, and after ten minutes' hard work the combined efforts of the home forwards resulted in their equalising from a melee in front of goal. It was at this stage that Dewey had to retire hurt. Half-time:

HINCKLEY, one goal;

BURTON SWIFTS, one goal.

On resuming a goal was given against Burton, and the leather was taken into close proximity of the visitors' goal, but their backs were safe. Play then continued very even, till Gilchrist got in a straight but slow shot, which one was surprised at the visitors' custodian not stopping, and scored the second goal for Hinckley. Soon after Beadsworth increased the lead after some clever work on the wing. Baxter at this stage unfortunately strained his knee when kicking, and changed positions with Beadsworth on the wing. A few minutes after this the Swifts scored again. Though Burton worked hard to equalise the result was:

LEICESTERSHIRE SENIOR FOOTBALL LEAGUE.

The Management Committee of this League met at the George Hotel, Leicester, on Wednesday evening. Mr. J. E. Carpenter presided, and there were present Messrs. H T. Dunn (Loughborough), H. White (Hinckley), J. M. Fergusson (hon. treasurer), and W. E. Jones (hon. secretary).—Whitwick Town wrote resigning membership of the League, and it was decided to accept their resignation, subject to the club paying deposit and subscription for the current season. In order to keep the League up to its proper strength it was resolved that applications to fill the vacancy should be received by the hon. secretary up to Monday next, after which date no application to be entertained. Barwell Swifts were awarded £1 as travelling expenses to Coalville on April 29th. Gresley Rovers were ordered to pay fines and money due to Loughborough by Sept. 15. It was resolved that all deposits, subscriptions, etc, for the ensuing season be paid by Sept. 18th. Rev. J. W. A. Mackenzie (Whitwick) was unanimously elected president of the League. The referees for September and October were chosen.

ANNUAL MEETING.

The annual meeting of the above league was held on Saturday night, at the George Hotel, Mr. J. E. Carpenter presiding. There were also present Messrs. S. Goacher (Coalville Albion), H. White (Hinckley Town), R. B. Mansfield (Gresley Rovers), H. Orton (Earl Shilton), W. Bray (Barwell), C. H. Williams (Nuneaton Town), B. Hull (Swadlincote), C. E. Marston (Coalville Town), T. Moss (Hugglescote R.H.), W. H. Harris (late secretary of the league, now of Kettering), and J. M. Fergusson (Leicester).—The report issued by the hon. secretary (Mr. J. W. Ferguson) showed that the league had done good work during the past season.—The report was adopted.—The statement of accounts, showing a deficit of £3 11s. 7d., was also adopted.—The two retiring clubs (both eligible for re-election) were Anstey and Loughborough Reserves. Neither of them, however, sought re-election.—Application for admission into the league was made by Nuneaton Town, and it was unanimously decided to admit them.—It was stated that other clubs were anxious for admission, and their claims will be considered at a future meeting.—A proposal was made that the Management Committee should meet alternately at Leicester, Coalville, and Hinckley. It was argued that if the resolution was carried it would save expense to some of the clubs; but on the other hand, it was contended that it would be wisest to continue as before, namely, that the Management Committee should meet at Leicester. The resolution was lost.—A proposition to reduce the deposit money from two guineas to one guinea was also lost, as, too, was the motion, "That the Management Committee be abolished, and the management be vested in one representative from each club."—It was decided that in Rule 3, after the word "chairman," the words "hon. treasurer" be inserted.—The following new rule was made:—"No player shall be allowed to play in league matches unless he be a bona-fide member of the club he plays for. The association certificate of registration shall be the only official registration form from which the hon. secretary of the league shall register playing members, and that the date of such registration shall count from the date of the association certificate, and before such players shall be considered as registered players of the league the association certificate shall bear the endorsement of the hon. secretary of this league, and which shall be forwarded to the said hon. secretary for the last-named purpose within three days of its receipt from the association."—N.B.—In the case of clubs not under the jurisdiction of the Leicestershire F.A., the names of all players shall be sent to the league secretary within seven days of election at a proper committee meeting of the club.—The election of president and vice-presidents was held over to a future meeting.—Mr. J. E. Carpenter was re-appointed chairman of the league, Mr. W. E. Jones was elected secretary, and Mr. J. M. Fergusson treasurer.—The members of the management committee were elected as follows:—Messrs. H. T. Dunn, H. S. Goacher, and W. White, together with the secretary, treasurer, and chairman of the league.—A cordial vote of thanks was passed to last season's officials.
